

**Auberry Service Center, Bass Lake, Kerckhoff Lake, Kern River,  
Kings River, Manzanita Lake, and Wishon Reservoir Planning Units  
Public Information Meeting  
Clovis Veterans Memorial Hall - Clovis, CA  
April 21, 2011 - 3:00 to 6:00 pm**

A public information meeting was hosted by the Stewardship Council on April 21, 2011 at the Clovis Veterans Memorial Hall in Clovis, California. The meeting concerned the following seven planning units: Auberry Service Center, Bass Lake, Kerckhoff Lake, Kern River, Kings River, Manzanita Lake, and Wishon Reservoir. A total of 18 people attended and participated in the meeting, representing a wide variety of interests, including local and federal governments, community organizations, and community members. The meeting was advertised via an e-mail sent to contacts in our database, an announcement posted on the Stewardship Council's web site, a press release in the local newspaper, and a postcard sent to all landowners on record that reside within one mile of any PG&E parcel associated with the seven planning units that were the focus of the meeting.

The purpose of this meeting was to: (1) provide a review and update on the Stewardship Council's Land Conservation Program; and, (2) solicit additional public input on future stewardship of the seven planning units.

During the meeting, participants were invited to ask questions and provide comments on the seven planning units. Stations were set up with maps, other pertinent information, and easels with blank paper. Below is a summary of the notes that were recorded on the easels and provided on comment cards.

**Auberry Service Center**

- The conservation easement should not encumber or constrain the green energy job training program

**Bass Lake**

- Support for PG&E to retain ownership of the property located on the north shore of Bass Lake

**Kerckhoff Lake**

- Provide access from the San Joaquin River trail to Smalley Cove campground through the old bridge abutments

*No comments were received pertaining specifically to the Kern River, Kings River, Manzanita Lake, or Wishon Reservoir planning units.*
